\$100 towards fall term tuition for an athlete who participated in track at Ontario High School. Awarded by the Athletic Department.

Earl Blackaby Memorial Scholarship

Two scholarships for tuition support for Business Majors. Must have a 3.0 GPA and enroll as a full-time student. Recipients demonstrate outstanding character and financial need. Renewable for a second year.

Mary Gail Blackaby Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for Business Majors. Must have a 3.0 GPA and enroll as a full-time student. Recipients demonstrate outstanding character and financial need. Renewable for a second year.

Clara Ann Burdic Memorial Scholarship

Four scholarships available each year. Must be enrolled in the WINGS program. Recipients must show financial need and academic achievement

Loretta Cables Scholarship

Tuition support to a high school graduate residing within the TVCC service district. Based on financial need, academic achievement and outstanding character. Renewable for second year.

Capps Family Endowed Scholarship

Tuition support for a student from the local Oregon or Idaho area. Based on financial need and academic achievement. Renewable for second year.

Chapter AF PEO Scholarship

Graduate from local Oregon or Idaho high school, sufficient academic achievement, registered as a full-time student, female, incoming freshman, good character, community involvement, and financial need. Awarded by the AF PEO Chapter. May be renewable.

Chapter K PEO Mildred Wood Scholarship

Tuition support awarded to female non-traditional student who is a resident of the Oregon or Idaho area. Based on financial need.

Lowell & Rosemary Cox Scholarship

Four scholarships awarded based on academic potential, community service and financial need. Must maintain a 2.0 GPA and be enrolled for 12 credit hours. Renewable for second year.

Laura Moore Cunningham Foundation Scholarship

Awarded annually to students from Idaho. Qualifications will be based on academic excellence, strong work ethic, leadership experience, a well-rounded personable character, financial need and a 3.0 GPA, which must be maintained. Renewable for a second year.

Opal Curry Dean Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for a non-traditional student (usually returning to education following an absence), studying an academic curriculum in education, preferably elementary education.

Hilda D. Elliott Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for students majoring in Business, Accounting or Nursing. Renewable for a second year.

Epionce Sports Medicine Scholarship

Tuition support for an incoming freshman (not necessarily right out of high school) majoring in athletic training. Must be from the Western Treasure Valley. Must have a 3.0 GPA.

James & Harriett Flanagan Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC a second year nursing student. Recipient must agree to stay in the community (defined as Ontario, Payette, Fruitland, Nyssa, Vale or Weiser) and serve as a nurse for a period of two years following graduation. A signed agreement will be required of the recipient.

Ralph & Jean Fountain Memorial Scholarship

Two scholarships for tuition, fees and necessary book support for non-traditional students of Malheur and Baker counties. Renewable for a second year.

Louis Gasca Memorial Scholarship

Award for students returning to TVCC as sophomores after successfully completing one year at TVCC and working toward an Associate of Arts/Science degree. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and receiving the recommendation of the department chairs.

James Gerke Honorary Scholarship

Two awards for tuition support for students from the local Oregon or Idaho area, (family's preference is Idaho area) majoring in Criminal Justice or other law enforcement related program. Based on academic achievement, financial need and community service. Renewable for second year as long as cumulative 2.5 GPA is maintained.

Andrew "Bud" Greeley Natural Resources Scholarship

Tuition support for a student from Malheur Country for at least two years. Field of Study in soil conservation or related agricultural or natural resources field such as agronomy, rangeland resources or ecology, geology, crop management, fish & wildlife, forestry, agricultural education or engineering. Must maintain a 3.2 GPA.

Loran H. Halcom Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support to a student from the local Oregon or Idaho area. Based on academic achievement and financial need.

E.M. "Curly" & Clara Hauser Scholarship

Tuition support for a graduate from a Malheur County high school with a solid track record in Malheur County 4H or Future Farmers of America awarded by the Ag. Department. Must have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0. Renewable as long as 3.0 cumulative GPA is maintained.

Linda C. Huff Memorial Scholarship

Annual award to a student majoring in Law Enforcement or Criminal Justice.

Gertrude Johnson Memorial Scholarship

Two awards for tuition support to students based on academic achievement and community service. Renewable for a second year.

William Kaatz Scholarship

Award based on financial need and academic potential. Student must have clear educational and career goals to succeed at the college level. Renewable for a second year.

Ed Manker Scholarship

Awarded to a student athlete (baseball), based on character. Awarded by the Athletic Department.

Joe & Betty Marquina/Dyer & Sadie Bennett Scholarship

Two awards for tuition support awarded to a Malheur County high school graduate. Recipients must have educational and career goals and a financial need. Renewable for a second year.

George & Nellie Matsuura Scholarship

Award for tuition support for a TVCC music major awarded by the Music Department. Selection will be based on financial need, academic achievement.

Catherine Mezzano Memorial Scholarship

One award for a student with academic potential and financial need. Renewable for a second year.

Sig & Mitsuko Murakami Scholarship

One award for tuition support for students from agricultural families with demonstration of family's own support towards the educational goals of the student. Renewable for a second year.

Russell Myrick Memorial Scholarship

One award for a graduate from Nyssa or Ontario High School, and is considered an "at risk" student. Must complete high school & demonstrate necessary skills & dedication to succeed on a college level. Financial need and involvement in athletics. Not Renewable.

Richard B. Nelson Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support to a student from the local Idaho area; preference given to students from Weiser. Based on academic potential, financial need and community service. Renewable for a second year.

Peggy Newton Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship will be awarded to a "second" year nursing student (local Oregon and Idaho area). Recipient must agree to work as a registered nurse one year in the community following graduation. Awarded by Nursing Department.

Shizuo & Frances Nishimura Scholarship

Scholarship support awarded to second year student who has successfully completed his/her first year at TVCC; recipient must have clear educational and career goals with the potential to succeed at the college level with the intent to further his/her education after graduating from TVCC. Recipient must be from the local Oregon or Idaho area. Not renewable.

Nyssa Volunteer Fire Department Scholarship

Tuition support awarded to a student from the local Oregon area with preference to a student from Nyssa. Based on financial need, academic achievement. Recipient may be a recent high school graduate or non-traditional student. Not Renewable.

Sgt. John Ogburn III Memorial Scholarship

Two awards for tuition support for one male and one female student from the Malheur, Payette or Washington County. Student must have a 3.0 GPA, financial need and achievement in extra-curricular activities and community service.

Ontario Kiwanis Club

Tuition support for an Ontario High School graduate. Must have been a member of the OHS Leadership Class, have community involvement, student academic record and financial need.

Ontario Optimist Club Scholarship

Awarded to a sophomore athlete who has successfully completed their freshman year at TVCC. Based on maintaining a 3.0 college GPA and student must have graduated from a high school within the TVCC taxing district.

Ontario Women's Club Endowment

Two scholarships awarded to students majoring in the following disciplines: business, literature, music, agriculture, nursing, social science, drama and art. Awarded in order of discipline shown.

Oregon Association Chiefs of Police Scholarship

Awarded by the Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police.

Oregon Sheriffs Association & Ron Mallee Memorial Scholarship

Recipients are required to enroll as full-time student, maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and major in Criminal Justice. Awarded by Ontario retired Chief of Police.

Harry L. Peterson Scholarship

Tuition support for a TVCC athlete recommended by athletic director.

Betty Lou Powers Scholarship

Award for a student majoring in Music. Must have clear educational and career goals with the potential to succeed at the college level. Renewable for a second year. Recipient will be recommended by the Music Department.

Tip Powers Scholarship

Award for a student majoring in Business. Must have clear educational and career goals with the potential to succeed at the college level. Renewable for a second year.

Prudi Sherman Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC students. Selection will be based on financial need, academic achievement.

Sterling Savings Bank Scholarship

Award for a student majoring in Business, having a Financial Need, and must maintain 2.5 GPA.

Stoneberg Boenig Scholarship

Award for a nursing student from Malheur County.

Wayne Takami Memorial Scholarship

Award to a Fine or Applied Arts major who demonstrates financial need. A 3.0 GPA must be maintained and student must be full time. Not renewable for second year.

Dr. Benjamin & Mrs. Michiye Tanaka Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC students. Call for specific criteria. Renewable for second year.

Dr. Robert Thornfeldt "20 Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for a TVCC second year nursing student, financial need, graduated from high school in either Baker, Canyon, Malheur, Payette, or Washington Counties. Recipient must agree to work in the community as a RN for one year. Awarded by the Nursing Department.

Karen Tipton Memorial Scholarship

Award to a non-traditional student (usually someone who is returning to school after an absence). Preference given to female students. Renewable for second year.

Hallie Urquhart Memorial Scholarship

Two awards for entering freshman students with a minimum GPA of 2.0. Must be civic minded and have demonstrated interest and involvement in their community, attended high school within Malheur, Grant or Harney County. Based on financial need and community service. Renewable for second year as long as 3.0 GPA is maintained.

Valley Family Health Care Foundation Scholarship in Memory of Linda Morgan

Award for a student accepted into the nursing program (all prerequisites have been met), have financial need, resident of Malheur, Payette, Gem or Washington Counties, and shows promise of completion of the nursing program and a subsequent successful nursing career.

William Van Atta Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000 to a non-traditional student from Malheur County (usually returning to education following an absence), studying an academic curriculum of their choice with demonstrated potential and financial need.

Kango & Nobue Wada Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC students. Call for specific criteria. Renewable for second year.

Drex and Irene Williams Scholarship

Award for a student from the rural Malheur or Harney counties with preference given to students from the Juntura school district area or the Drewsey-Pine Creek school district. They must have at least a 3.0 average to qualify for award. Renewable for second year.

WINGS Anonymous Scholarship

Varying award amounts for students enrolled in TVCC WINGS program. Must show academic potential and financial need.

Ben & Laurine Wrenn Memorial Scholarship

Award to a TVCC graduating sophomore who is transferring to a four-year program by the President of TVCC. Student should have high academic achievement and be of good character.
